

EXCHANGE VS NON-EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

Students awarded an “**exchange**” spot will pay their regular UNC tuition and fees for their time abroad (rather than paying tuition abroad). This is generally the most cost-effective option for students who regularly pay in-state tuition at UNC.

Students who choose to pursue a program as a “**non-exchange**” student will pay the host university’s study abroad tuition and fees (rather than paying UNC tuition and fees). The cost is often comparable or less than what out-of-state students typically pay for UNC tuition.
